About the Workshops:

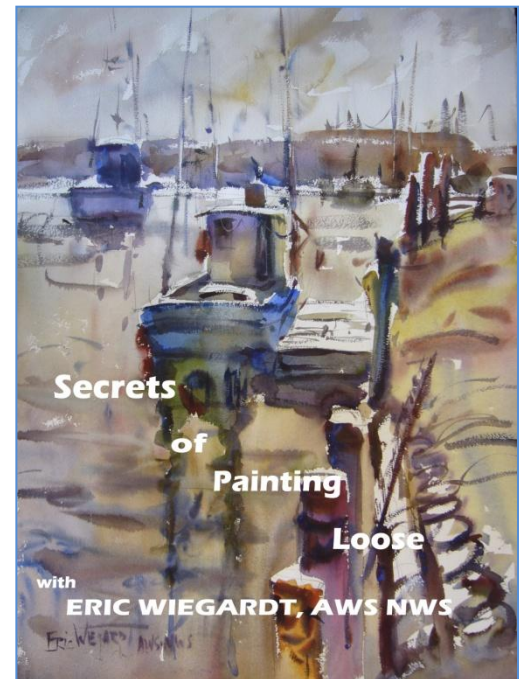
